#### Invocation when putting on new clothes

Allaahumma lakal-hamdu Anta kasawtanihi, as'aluka min khairihi wa khairi maa suni'a lahu, wa a'uthu bika min sharrihi wa sharri ma suni'a lahu.

Oh Allâh, praise is to You. You have clothed me. I ask You for its goodness and the goodness of what it has been made for, and I seek Your protection from the evil of it and the evil of what it has been made for.<sup>20</sup>

### When Wearing A New Garment

Allaahumma innee a'u<u>th</u>ubika an adhilla, aw udhalla, aw azilla, aw uzalla, aw a<u>dh</u>lima, aw u<u>dh</u>lama, aw ajhala aw yujhala 'alayya.

Oh Allâh, I seek refuge in You lest I misguide others, or I am misguided by others, lest I cause others to err or I am caused to err, lest I abuse others or be abused, and lest I behave foolishly or meet with the foolishness of others.
