IS Objective: Learning Objective: Analyze, classify and evaluation the different types of worship

Cooperative Learning Strategy: Silent Card Shuffle

Silent card shuffle is a cooperative learning activity designed to develop student's higher thinking skills. The activity requires students to classify, arrange, match, map and critique concepts related to types of worship.

Dr. Bloom explained that the cognitive process for learning has dimensions that can be developed through training and practice. The researchers of Bloom's taxonomy explain that remembering, understanding, applying, analyzing, evaluating and creating are all stages of cognitive thinking.

During the silent card shuffle activity some cognitive skills will be exercised. Students are required to select, analyze, classify, arrange and match cards related to worship while working in a group.

Five-Phase Strategy:

Phase One: The class will be broken down into six groups. Each group will consist of

- (1) Group Leader
- (2) Recorder
- (3) Group Representative
- (4) Time Keeper

Phase Two: Each group will receive four general categories and 43 cards with different types of worship on them that match the four different categories. Ten cards each match the four different categories. Three odd cards will be given to test the group's ability to detect cards that do not match with the categories.

Phase Three: With no speaking to each other the group will, shuffle the forty-three cards, analyze, classify, arrange and match the cards under one of four general categories. Time keeper must keep track of time. Group recorder must record the data off of their SCS board. The Group leader must make the final decision and place the card on the board. (20 minutes).

Phase Four: The group representative from each group will go to the next group and analyze, evaluate and critique their SCS board. Record the any cards that are not under the right category. (Five minutes)

Phase Five: Group representatives will return to their group and wait for teacher to reveal the correct cards that should be under each of the four categories.

For each card that was correctly placed upper the right category receives one point. If the representative identifies a card that is missed placed card that team is award one point. Points will be given to each group and a grade recorded.
